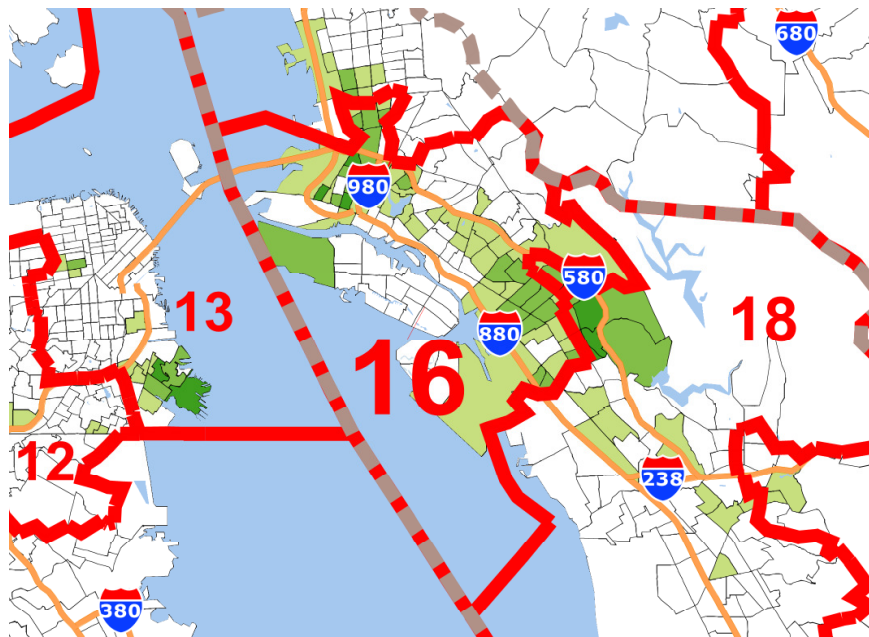


African Americans and Redistricting: SECURING POLITICAL POWER
